### Emergency Response: Safety in Every Season

This winter, with temperatures plummeting and risks rising, you helped us respond with care and urgency. Here's how:

Warm clothing, hot meals, and emergency gear were delivered by outreach teams across the city. Transportation support and shelter referrals ensured people had safe places to go. Our teams worked through extreme cold to show up for the community – and you were right there with us.

# Triage: Essential Services, Right When They're Needed

Our triage team provides critical first connections - for many, it's the first step toward housing, care, and community. This year, your support allowed us to:

Help thousands obtain ID – an essential key to housing, income, and healthcare.

Provide dependable mail services, ensuring that people receive vital documents.

Offer individuals pathways to housing, health, and other services through caring, trauma-informed intake.

You helped ensure that people got the right support at the right time – preventing crises from becoming chronic.



## Reconciliation in Action: Restoring Relationships to Elders, Land, Language, and Ceremony

We do this work because reclaiming culture, identity, and community – long disrupted by colonization – is key to healing. For the more than 75% of those we serve who identify as Indigenous, connection to elders, land, language, and ceremony is not only meaningful – it's essential. This year, your generosity helped:

Reconnect individuals with elders, ceremony, and language through safe and welcoming spaces.

Support land-based teachings and healing that honour Indigenous knowledge, including sweat lodges, smudging, access to protocol, and medicine picking.

Rekindle relationships between youth and knowledge keepers to support cultural identity and connection.

This work reflects the spirit of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Calls to Action - by supporting Indigenous-led healing, ceremony, and land-based cultural revitalization.


